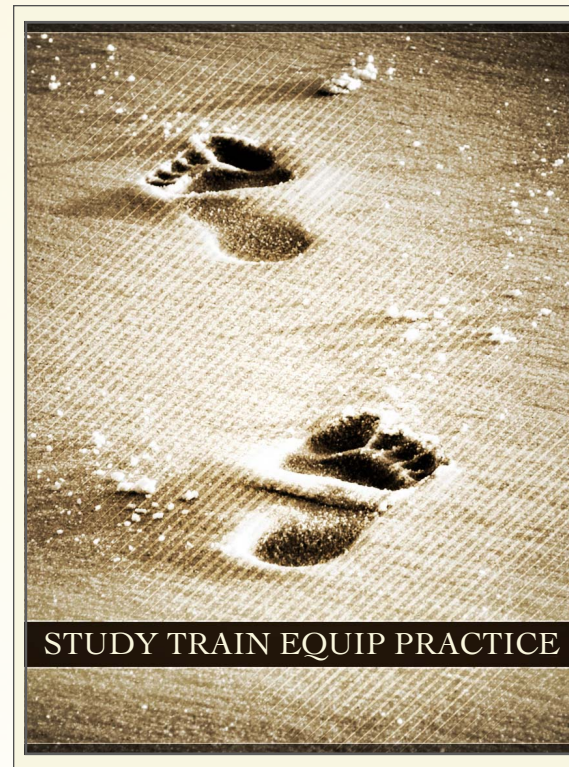

Using basic timelines, maps, photos and bios, the class will help you fit the pieces together and better understand the time and place in which people like Jeremiah, Jesus and Paul spoke to their audience.
