Captured live and unscripted, pastor and author Timothy Keller meets with a group of people to address their doubts and objections to Christianity. Using literature, philosophy, real-life experiences, and the Bible, Keller and the group explore the truth of Christianity. This class is designed to help you learn how to engage others in dialogue on some of the common objections to Christianity. Each class will involve watching a short video, and afterwards the group will engage in a discussion over the specific topic that's addressed. Some of the questions we will be coming in the second session of this class are: "Why does God allow suffering?" and "How can God be so full of love and wrath at the same time?" *The Reason for God* is a resource for what to say in response to these objections, and a model for how to say it.

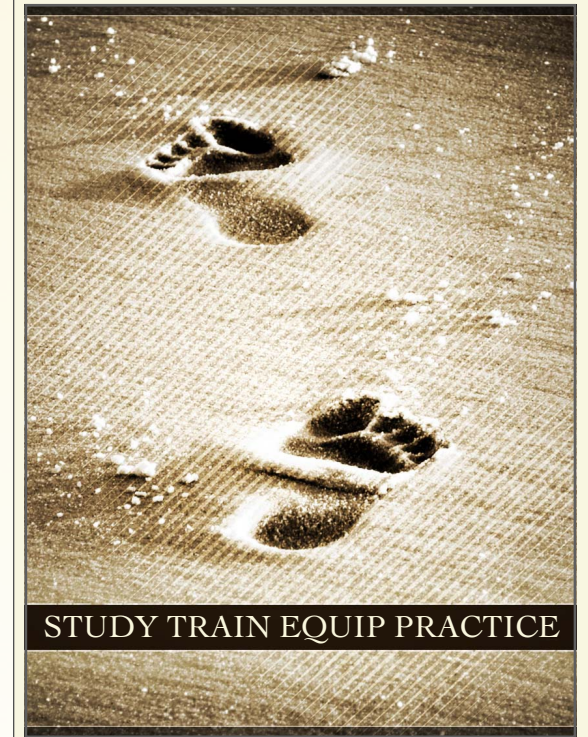
